Job responsibilities will include:

School Culture

- This position includes on-campus housing, when available;
- Create positive, achievement-oriented and structured learning environment with high "joy-factor" so that students are excited about and invested in their academic excellence;
- Set and hold students to extremely high academic and behavioral standards;
- Build rapport with students and families outside of class;
- Assume responsibility for every single scholar's success by holding all students accountable during transitions, meals, trips, and other learning opportunities;
- Collaborate with colleagues to ensure a rigorous, joyful, and safe environment across the entire campus;

Academic

- Learn and implement the curriculum for assigned grade level;
- Research and create lessons that complement/supplement the curriculum;
- Track and assess student academic progress and attendance;

- Individualize instruction to help each student achieve curricular objectives;
- Provide students and caregivers with regular feedback regarding student performance and progress;
- Generate informal and formal reports regarding student performance and progress;
