The Position

This is a part time position that reports to the instructional lead at the Academy.

This position is for a highly driven educator to serve as a member of the Academy's instructional team to ensure optimal learning outcomes. Candidates who are seeking to fulfill the requirements for their practicum or supervised clinical experience are encouraged to apply.

Candidate Qualities

The Academy is seeking a Speech and Language Pathologist who:

- Will enthusiastically embrace the mission and philosophy of the Academy and serve as a passionate ambassador, both within and outside the school
- Has clinical and instructional experience working with diverse populations
- Has a collaborative style and is flexible with varied responsibilities
- Has a genuine interest in a long term and deeply satisfying role in the Academy.
- Is forward thinking, highly organized and takes initiative
- Will provide individualized speech and language assessment and intervention to help each student achieve curricular objectives
- Provide students, teachers, and families with regular feedback regarding student performance and progress

Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Assessing students' speech and language skills (e.g. articulation, fluency, voice, expressive and receptive language, etc.) for the purpose of identifying communication disorders, determining program eligibility and developing recommendations for treatment
- Devising, implementing and revising relevant therapy programs
- Designing customized speech and language therapy treatment plans based on needs, academic needs assessments, and other pertinent faculty reports



- Serving as liaison between the teachers, parents, other academic support staff, and administrators to enhance the academic progress of students
- Maintaining knowledge of classroom curriculum
- Writing and maintaining confidential case notes and reports. Providing ongoing communication of student progress.
